

Following is a summary of *changes* to the Procedural Safeguards Manual for Parents. This is in no way a comprehensive description of the rights, only a description of the *changes*. For a complete description of the safeguards, please see the Procedural Safeguards Manual for Parents (August 2011).

**Procedural Safeguards Manual for Parents August 2011 compared to
Procedural Safeguards Manual for Parents December 2008**

1. Updated contact information for the AEAs, the ASK Resource Center, and Disability Rights Iowa.
2. Removal of most references to the “preappeal conference,” in light of the 2011 rules revisions.
3. Additional and updated information about transfer of rights, in light of the 2010 amendments to the Iowa Code.
4. Revised forms for Due Process Complaints, IDEA State Complaints, and Mediation Requests:
 - In all three forms, there is now a place for the child’s date of birth.
 - The Due Process Complaint form removes the question about agreement to participate in a resolution session.
 - The IDEA State Complaint form removes language that purported to restrict the state complaint process to procedural questions only.
 - The Mediation form is renamed, in light of the rules revisions about “preappeal conferences.”
