Course Description

In partnership with Grant Wood AEA and the Area 10 Perkins Consortium, The University of Iowa's Jacobson Institute for Youth Entrepreneurship is offering Area 10 high school teachers' entrepreneurship training. The two-day training provides strategies and methods for integrating entrepreneurial education across disciplines. The workshop is sponsored by Grant Wood AEA. Perkins Funding will reimburse the school district for 2 days of substitute teacher costs. In addition, Grant Wood will purchase licenses for participating teachers to receive access to YouthBizCentral, an online entrepreneurship curriculum tied to the Common Core and 21st Century Skills beginning in April 2011 through June 2012 (value = \$250). License renewal and graduate credit is available for an additional fee.

Participants should bring 2-3 business ideas with them to the two-day training.
