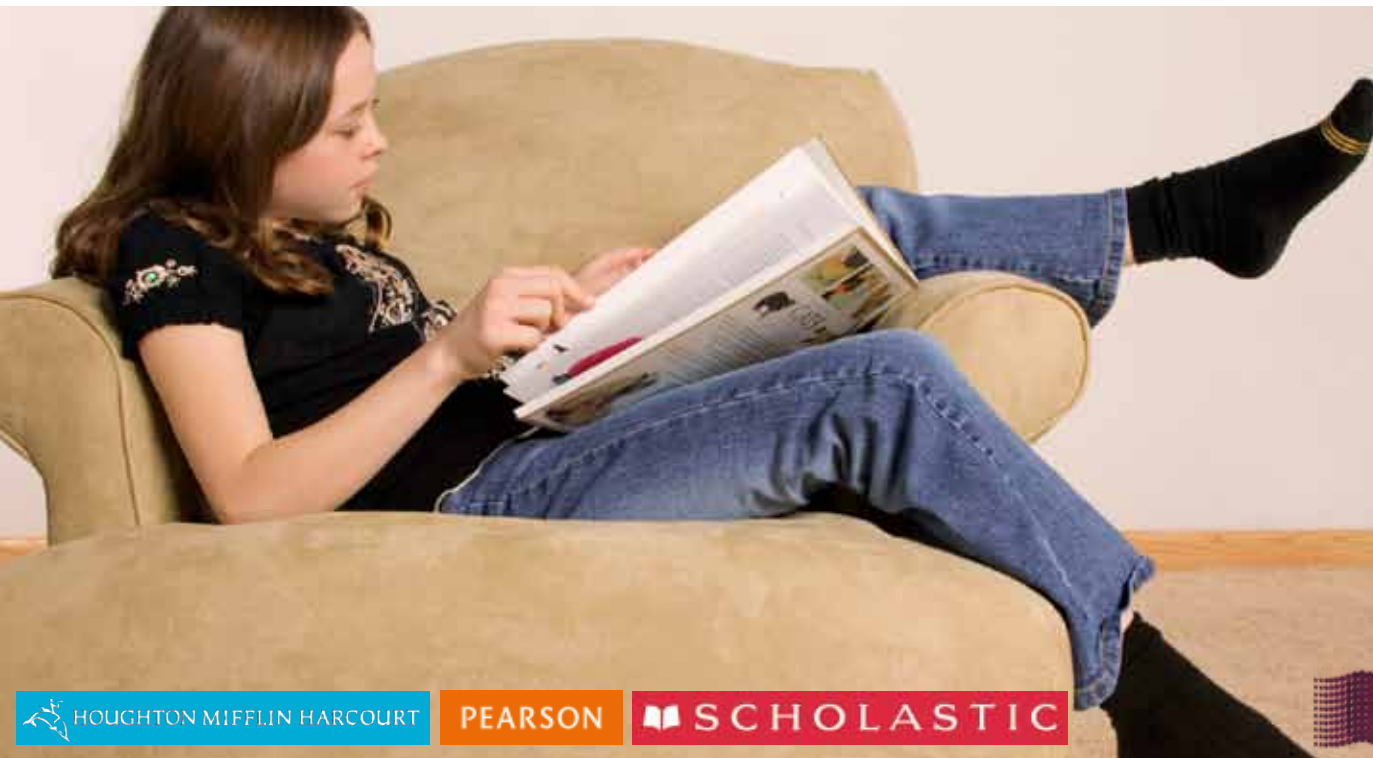
Participants will:
